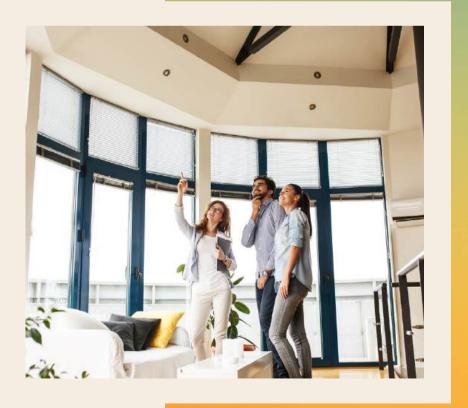

## Approach & Method

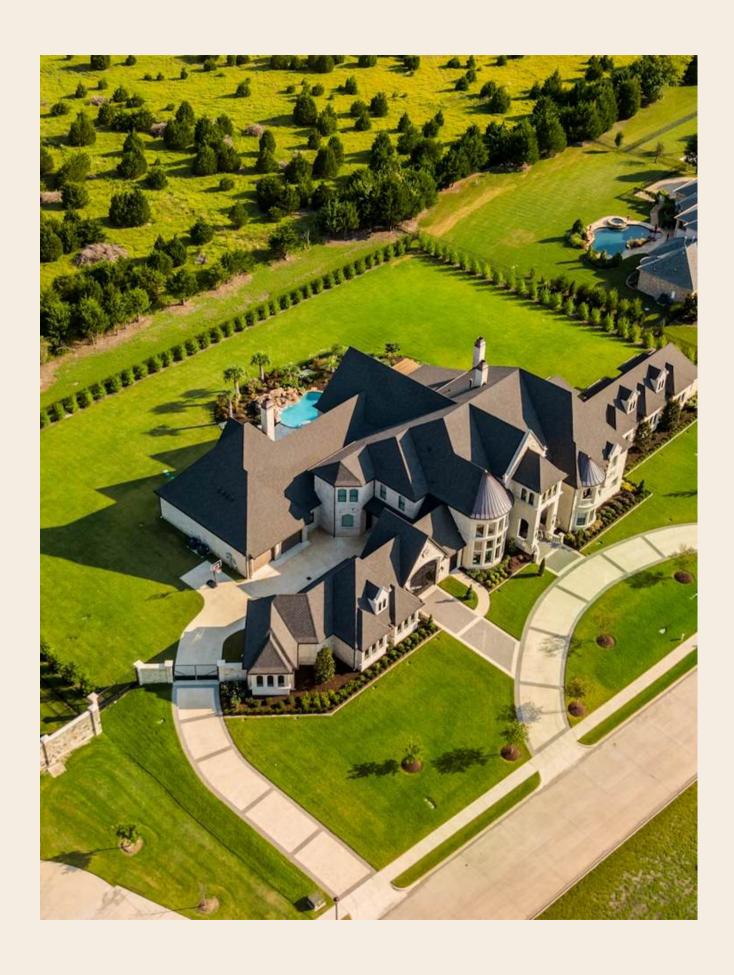
### Approach
